



**Need to get your license reinstated so you can drive to work or to job training?**

**If your license is suspended and you can't afford to pay to get it reinstated, you may be able to get help to pay the reinstatement fee and to pay for financial responsibility insurance.**

**Here is how you may qualify for the PRC (Prevention Retention Contingency) benefit that could pay your license reinstatement fee and for financial responsibility insurance.**

- ◆ You are the parent, legal guardian or custodian or specified relative of a minor child or you are pregnant or your spouse is expecting a child within three months.
- ◆ You meet PRC income limits of 200 percent of federal poverty guidelines.
- ◆ You are a citizen or a qualified alien.
- ◆ You cannot be a fugitive felon or in a family that fraudulently received public assistance under PRC or OWF unless the amount owed has been paid in full.
- ◆ Your driver's license is necessary to obtain or maintain employment or training or to stay in school.
- ◆ You show that public transportation is not safely available to you to get to work, training or classes.
- ◆ You are eligible to have your license reinstated. That generally means that you have served the full suspension period and have paid all fines, damages and court costs. PRC funds are not available to pay fines, damages or court costs.
- ◆ There are other requirements to qualify for PRC. Check with your case worker or phone 216-987-7000.
